



## EQUIVALENCY OF TRAINING

### SAMPLE QUESTIONS

1. You respond to a noise complaint in an apartment complex. You are invited into a residence where a group of adults are highly intoxicated. Among them are a five and seven year old child. Further observations show the children have not been bathed recently, do not have adequate clothing for the weather, and have been drinking alcoholic beverages. What should your immediate action be regarding the children?
  - A. Disband the party and notify the Department of Family and Children's Services for a follow-up investigation to determine the disposition of the children.
  - B. Take the children to a medical facility for evaluation and notify the Juvenile Intake Officer for placement of the children.
  - C. Take the children into protective custody and notify the Department of Family and Children's Services for placement.
  - D. Disband the party and hold the parents until a petition can be drawn up and taken to the court demanding the children be surrendered to authorities.
  
2. Your initial responsibility when responding to a felony in progress call is to:
  - A. arrest the suspect
